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enter the store, select a plastic storage container, head directly to the toy area from there and select different trading cards. The male would then exit the store through one of the side fire exits. The male was previously observed with a blonde, White Female, in a black 4 door sedan.

I took tactical position in the parking lot as I was on the phone with LPO Graham. She advised that she observed the bearded male wearing a black hat with a large white "A" on the front and a dark long-sleeved "Emirates" Jersey, and gray pants in the parking lot while I was present previously. The male entered a dark 4 door sedan and moved across the parking lot. When I left the area, the male and a blonde, White Female are observed inside of the vehicle as it parks in front of the general merchandise side of the store. The male exits the vehicle and enters the store at approximately 20:53 hours. LPO Graham observes the male grab a shopping cart and head to the Home section where he selects a gray plastic storage container with lid. The male then proceeds to the trading card wall at the rear of the store.

Once at the trading card wall, the male selects multiple Topps football, Elite baseball, Prism basketball and football, and NBS Hoops trading cards. The male places all of the card boxes inside of the gray plastic container and covers it with the lid. The male then slowly makes his way to the front of the store where he exits past all points of sale and runs across the parking lot to where the female was parked. I observed the male walking swiftly across the parking lot carrying the gray plastic container. As the male was reaching the vehicle, a black BMW sedan bearing FL Tag XME065 with the rear driver side door in the open position, I activated my emergency lights and positioned my vehicle in front of theirs.

The male placed the container on the ground and ran towards the vehicle. I initiated a high-risk takedown and ordered the female who was seated in the driver's seat to show me her hands as Corporal J. Smith and Deputy E. Bishop ordered the male to get on the ground. Once the male was secured, I ordered the female out of the vehicle and secure he in handcuffs. Once the female was removed from the vehicle, deputies observed in plain view what appeared to be crumpled tinfoil with burnt brown/black residue in the area of the center consol. From my training and experience, tinfoil is

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widely used and consistent for illicit narcotic usage. The male and female were positively identified by their Florida Identification Cards respectively as Andrew Tyler Simmons and Madeline Noel Whaley.

I advised Simmons of his Miranda Warnings to which he advised he understood. He acknowledged that he was headed to get into the previously mentioned vehicle and the driver was a friend of his. I asked him what he was going to do with all of the cards in the container and he advised that a friend, "

" told him to go to Palm Coast Target and steal them. He further advised that said friend would give him \$10.00 for a small box and \$20.00 for the large boxes of cards. I asked Simmons if he attempted to pay for any of the items at any point and he said "no", because he was just being stupid. Simmons additionally advised that he knew the difference between right and wrong.

The total cost of all items stolen and recovered by Target is \$2,555.98 to include 1 Hefty plastic bin and 98 packs of trading cards.

Upon searching the vehicle, Deputy Bishop located the following:

- four pieces of burnt tinfoil, located on top of the center console and inside the driver-side door.
- A black zipped container containing a smaller clear container of a white, crystal-like substance and a separate dime bag containing a white-powdered residue. The black container was located on top of the center console.
- A green container containing a clear glass pipe with burnt residue, located inside of the center console.
- A brown and black checkered Ed Hardy backpack, located on the rear driver-side seat containing the following items: A black Smith & Wesson .22 caliber semi-automatic handgun bearing SN The handgun was loaded with a bullet in the chamber and a magazine containing 10 rounds. A yellow DeWalt container containing a green, leafy substance. A multi-colored glass pipe with burnt residue.

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The backpack contained multiple female items including eyelashes and a multitude of makeup items as well as a small blue notebook with "Maddy" written on the front. I asked Simmons about the bag, and he advised that he was unaware of who it belonged to. Whaley advised that the backpack belonged to her husband.

A preliminary test of the crystal-like substance tested presumptive positive for methamphetamine with a total package weight of 5 grams. The powdery substance tested presumptive positive for fentanyl with an unmeasurable weight.

Upon running a check of the firearm, a positive HIT confirmation was received, and the firearm was stolen out of Jacksonville, see JSO Case #25-159363.

A criminal history inquiry was conducted for both subjects and the following was found:

Whaley, 1 previous conviction of Possession of Fentanyl by Orange County, FL on 07/22/2024 #2022-CF-002269-A-O.

Simmons, 1 previous conviction of PETIT THEFT MERCH/FARM/TRANSIT \$100-\$750 in Duval County, FL on 05/05/2026 with an adjudication of guilty. Additionally, Simmons had active warrants out of St. John's and Clay Counties.

-St. John's County for FTA REF CT1 POSS OF SCHEDULE II SUBSTANCE CT2 POSS OF PARAPHERNALIA NO BOND.

-Clay County x3 for LARC - GRAND THEFT 750 LESS THAN 5K DOLS, BOND AMT \$25,003, WARRANT #'S 26AF052634, 26AF052643, and 26AF052649 all signed by the Honorable Judge Whittington. All were served by SGT D. Parthemore.

Based on the fact that the narcotics and paraphernalia were located in the center console area of the vehicle and neither admitted to possessing said items, both Simmons and Whaley are being charged

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with the following:

-Possession of a controlled substance without a prescription (Fentanyl), a violation of F.S.S. 893.13.2.a.2.

-Possession of a controlled substance (Methamphetamine), a violation of F.S.S. 893.13.6.a.

-Possession of drug paraphernalia, a violation of F.S.S. 893.147.1.

Based on the fact that Simmons passed all points of sale without attempting to pay, he is being charged with SHOPLIFTING – GRAND THEFT \$750 - \$5K, a violation of F.S.S. 812.014.2.c.1.

Due to Whaley knowingly accompanying Simmons to Palm Coast from Jacksonville to commit said theft, she is being charged with ACCESSORY AFTER THE FACT 3RD DEG FEL RANK 3-10, a violation of F.S.S. 777.03.1.a.

Due to the Ed Hardy bag belonging to Whaley and the firearm was found inside, she is additionally charged with USE DISP ETC FIREARM DURING FELONY, a violation of F.S.S. 790.07.2. and POSS WEAP OR AMMO BY CONVICTED FLA FELON, a violation of F.S.S. 790.23.1.a., and GRAND THEFT – FIREARM, a violation of F.S.S. 812.014.2.c.5.

The previously mentioned vehicle was taken to the Flagler County Sheriff's Impound lot and a forfeiture packet was completed. The forfeiture notification was completed and served to both Whaley and Simmons.

A written statement was completed by LPO Graham and she wished to have both Whaley and Simmons trespassed from the property. Trespass warnings were completed and both Whaley and Simmons were duly warned to not return to the property.

LPO Graham completed a willingness to prosecute on behalf of Target.

Whaley and Simmons were transported to the Flagler County Inmate Facility without issue and turned

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
