COUNT 1

HAROLD F. PRYOR, State Attorney of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit of Florida, as Prosecuting Attorney for the State of Florida in the County of Broward, by and through his undersigned Assistant State Attorney, charges that February 1, 2021 and April 30, 2025, inclusive, in the County and State aforesaid, the defendant, **JOY YVETTE HOLDER**, did knowingly obtain or use, or endeavor to obtain or use, funds, assets, or property of an elderly or disabled person, in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) or more, belonging to [REDACTED] an elderly person or disabled adult, with the intent to temporarily or permanently deprive [REDACTED] of the use, benefit, or possession of the funds, assets, or property, or to benefit someone other than [REDACTED] and **JOY YVETTE HOLDER** stood in a position of trust and confidence with [REDACTED] or **JOY YVETTE HOLDER** had a business relationship with [REDACTED] and/or **JOY YVETTE HOLDER** did obtain or use, endeavor to obtain or use, or conspire with another to obtain or use funds, assets or property, in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) or more, belonging to [REDACTED] an elderly person or disabled adult, with the intent to temporarily or permanently deprive [REDACTED] of the use, benefit, or possession of the funds, assets, or property, or to benefit someone other than [REDACTED] and **JOY YVETTE HOLDER** knew or reasonably should have known that [REDACTED] lacked the capacity to consent; contrary to Sections 825.103(1)(a), (1)(b), 825.103(2) and 825.103(3)(a), Florida Statutes. 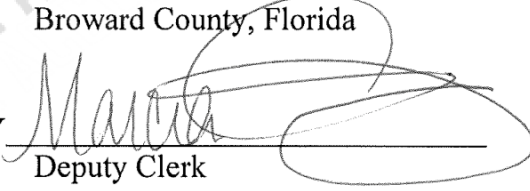
